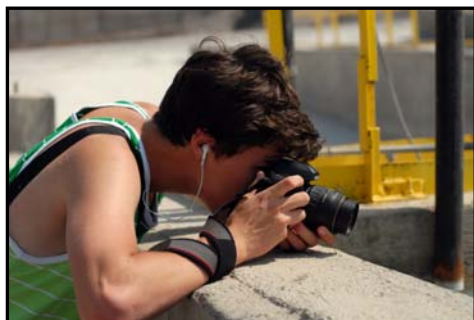

Free your imagination and be part of an inspiring adventure in the cutting edge fields of video, film making, chemical and digital photography, or computer arts in the School of Media Arts. Students will participate in exciting and challenging classes, work



sessions, critiques, lectures, field trips, and presentations by visiting artists. The curriculum stresses creative production and is not exclusively goal-oriented. Exploration, experimentation, and discovery are stressed. The process — an awareness of the avenues of discovery and stimulating detours — is as important as product. Your classes will include an introduction to the specific facilities, a review of fundamentals, an exploration of new techniques and processes, an overview of aesthetics, surveys of contemporary work, trends and ideas, and extensive production work that emphasizes individual or small group projects. Ongoing critical overview and critique will be directed toward your presentation of a final project. The program culminates with a final show.
