For your audition, you will perform a prepared vocal selection and sight-read standard vocal literature.

July 22 – August 18, 2012
 Skidmore College, Saratoga Springs

At the NYSSSA School of Orchestral Studies program, you will become a member of a symphony orchestra while studying with musicians from the Philadelphia Orchestra during the four week program in Saratoga Springs. You will rehearse and perform the same repertoire as the world-renowned orchestra during its summer residency at the Saratoga Performing Arts Center (SPAC). You will attend performances and rehearsals at SPAC and give concerts with your fellow orchestra members at SPAC

and the Empire State Plaza in Albany all under the baton of Artistic Director Luis Biava. For your audition, you will give a solo performance that displays your technical and musical abilities and sight-read standard instrumental selections.
