Students must submit at least 10 examples of their art work. Large paintings, framed paintings, ceramics, sculpture, and 3-dimensional work should be presented by photograph or digital format . Two views should be included for three-dimensional work.

A portfolio or red rope envelope up to 31" x 42" will be accepted. All artwork must fit within the portfolio. Portfolios containing artwork which extends beyond the dimensions of the portfolio will not be accepted. Contents should be clearly numbered and marked with your name and high school. We strongly encourage students to submit artwork from direct observation. Included in the submission should be a self-portrait from observation (not a photograph). We encourage you to submit your sketchbooks. Digital submissions and small photos should be placed in an envelope and taped to the inside of the portfolio.

Slides and small photos should be placed in an envelope and taped to the inside of the portfolio. All work should be clearly marked with number of entry, your name, and school.
